Notable premiers of Dr. Callahan's music have taken place in Westminster Abbey, King's College Cambridge, Harvard and Yale Universities, the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C., and St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City. Dr. Callahan's *The Song of Mary* for full orchestra, choir, cantor and congregation was commissioned by the Archdiocese of New York for last month's Papal Mass in New York City.
