Jeannine is a champion of the organ and its music. She has traveled throughout the US and the world promoting and sharing organ music through her innovative concerts. As a professional organist she enjoys a varied career. Besides concertizing and recording, Jeannine has held university teaching positions and has served in a variety of positions in church music ministry. She is also the President and founder of *Pro-Motion Music* — a company celebrating the world of the organ. Dr. Jordan was awarded the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Organ Performance and Music History from the University of Oregon where early American organists was the subject of her dissertation. This study led to further research and collaboration with media artist, David Jordan to create *From Sea to Shining Sea* as well as a CD of American organ music.

David Jordan, a skilled pianist with a Master of Music degree in composition from Ball State University, is also a media artist. Whether creating the visual portions the Jordan's organ and media events or reimagining photographs, his work inspires and mesmerizes its viewers.

The Jordans are also the creators and performers of *Bach and Sons*, an organ and multi-media event celebrating the life and times of Johann Sebastian Bach and his family. CDs recorded on historic organs in Bach's Germany by Dr. Jordan include *The Music of Bach and Sons* and *The Chorales of Martin Luther*.
