Murtagh/McFarlane Artists Management Gothic Records <u>epiphanies</u> by Daniel Pinkham was composed on commission from House of Hope Presbyterian Church, Saint Paul, MN, for the inauguration of the C.B. Fisk organ and premiered by Joan Lippincott. It was written during June, July and August 1978. The term <u>epiphany</u> is used in its original Greek sense: i.e. an appearance or a becoming manifest, especially of a deity. The work consists of five movements, of which three will be heard this afternoon, each preceded by a New Testament quotation, which, although not programmatic, reflects the affect or emotional state of the Biblical passage.



Jesus was born at Bethlehem in Judaea during the reign of Herod. After his birth astrologers from the east arrived in Jerusalem, asking, 'Where is the child who is born to be king of the Jews? We observed the rising of his star, and we have come to pay him homage.' King Herod was greatly perturbed when he heard this; and so was the whole of Jerusalem. He called a meeting of the chief priests and lawyers of the Jewish people, and put before them the question; 'Where is it that the Messiah is to be born?' 'At Bethlehem in Judaea', they replied.

Herod next called the astrologers to meet him in private, and ascertained from them when the star had appeared. He then sent them on to Bethlehem, and said, 'Go and make a careful inquiry for the child. When you have found him, report to me, so that I may go myself and pay him homage.'

They set out at the king's bidding; and the star which they had seen at its rising went ahead of them until it stopped above the place where the child lay. At the sight of the star they were overjoyed. Entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and bowed to the ground in homage to him; then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And being warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned home another way.
