Following studies at the University of Illinois (Bachelor of Music, 1983) and at Southern

Methodist University (Master of Music, Master of Sacred Music, 1985), he received a Fulbright scholarship for study in France. A student of Marie-Claire Alain and of Huguette Dreyfus at the Conservatoire National de Rueil-Malmaison, he was awarded unanimous first prizes in organ in 1986 and in harpsichord in 1987.

A laureate of numerous international organ competitions, including Nuremberg in 1987 and Dublin in 1986, Matthew Dirst was a finalist in the 10th Grand Prix de Chartres in 1986 (in Interpretation). Recent engagements have included concerts in England, Ireland, France, Germany, and the United States. He is currently a doctoral student at Stanford University, where he holds a university teaching fellowship.
